



Parents are forever. Although parents can divorce each other, their *children are not divorceable*. Each parent is responsible for nurturing and creating their children's sense of security and well-being — even through the divorce process. *Focus on Kids* was designed to help you with that task.

What will I gain?

After attending *Focus On Kids*, which is only two and one-half hours long, you will:

- ♦ Understand the importance of ongoing, supportive and nurturing involvement by both parents.
- ♦ Receive information on both children's and adolescents' developmental needs, abilities and common reactions to divorce.
- ♦ Learn specific behaviors that help in a co-parenting situation and those that should be avoided.

How do I register?

Pre-registration is required for each parent. A \$45 per-person fee, payable to Polk County Extension, can be paid in advance, or immediately prior to the start of class.

To reschedule: *Call the Polk County Extension Office by noon the day before you are registered to attend.*

A minimum of 5 participants are required for class to be held.

What else do I need to know?

- ♦ You and the other parent must attend on separate dates.
- ♦ Childcare is not provided so children are not allowed to attend.
- ♦ Sign-in and sign-out is required. Plan to arrive 10 minutes early and to stay for the entire 2.5 hours session.
- ♦ Attendance is confirmed after you have completed a session.
